Purpose of Letter and Agreement:

This letter serves as a formal agreement between the Animal Owner and the Recipient for the transfer, care, and management of the animal described herein. The Recipient agrees to provide proper care, treatment, housing, and nourishment consistent with applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations governing animal welfare. The Animal Owner confirms ownership rights and grants the Recipient authorization to act in the animal's best interest within the scope of this Agreement.

Terms and Conditions:

1. Ownership and Transfer of Possession

The Animal Owner affirms sole ownership of the animal and transfers possession rights to the Recipient. This transfer does not include transfer of ownership unless separately documented and agreed upon in writing.

2. Care and Welfare

The Recipient agrees to provide proper shelter, food, water, veterinary care, and humane treatment at all times, complying with all applicable laws, regulations, and standards for animal welfare.

3. Veterinary Care and Emergencies

The Recipient shall obtain and maintain veterinary care as necessary to preserve the animal's health and well-being, including vaccinations, treatments, and emergency care. The Animal Owner shall be notified of any serious health concerns immediately.

4. Liability

The Recipient assumes all liability for injury, damage, or loss caused by or to the animal during the term of possession. The Animal Owner shall not be liable for any claims, damages, or injuries arising from the animal's actions while in

Recipient's care.

5. Duration and Return of Animal

The term of this Agreement shall continue until terminated by mutual written consent or upon demand by the Animal Owner. Upon termination, the Recipient shall promptly return the animal in good health and condition, reasonable wear and age excepted.

6. Compliance with Laws

Both parties agree to comply with all federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and ordinances relating to the care, treatment, and ownership of the animal.

7. Confidentiality of Information

Any personal or sensitive information exchanged between the parties shall be treated as confidential and not disclosed to third parties except as required by law.

8. Governing Law and Venue

This Agreement is governed by the laws of the United States and the specific state mutually agreed upon by the parties. Any disputes arising out of or relating to this Agreement shall be resolved exclusively in the state or federal courts located in the agreed jurisdiction.

9. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties and supersedes all prior communications, representations, or agreements, whether oral or written. No modification shall be effective unless in writing and signed by both parties.

10. Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

11. Counterparts

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and together constitute one and the same instrument.

12. Signatures

The parties affirm that they have read, understood, and voluntarily accept the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement, and hereby execute it as of the date of signing.
